- Actor type puzzles
  - Live stream escape game with actor
  - Actor says odd words in video/ shows clue
- Escape game type puzzles
- SpectrographClues in 106, 206, and 406
- Clue in Latitude and Longitude of Salisbury (42°16'28.2"N 71°48'25.2"W)
- Have a clue written as a haiku (but missing 1 syllable that people need to fill in)
- Hide clues in inspect area of website
- Vigenere cipher, where 2 keys lead to 2 different messages from same sample text
- Clue hidden when opening a non txt file in Notepad (A classic of ARGs)

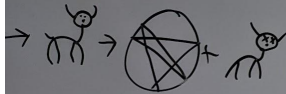

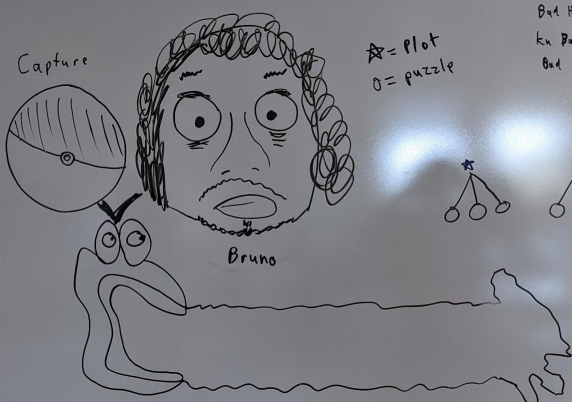

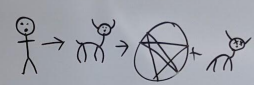

**\*Comic Idea: Graffiti wall with text gets some letters/words crossed out and it spells something**

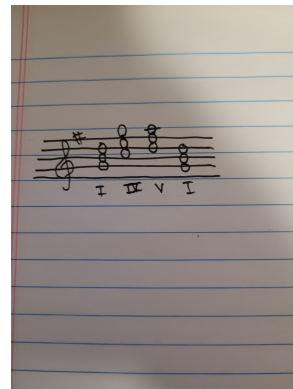

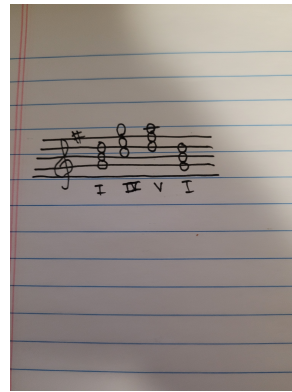
